Titles

CAJC	The qualifying certificate for the Slovak Junior Champion title can be awarded to a dog and a bitch that is excellent 1 in junior class.
CAC	The qualifying certificate for the Slovak Champion title can be awarded to a dog and a bitch that is excellent 1 in intermediate, open and champion class.
r. CAC	Can be awarded to a dog and a bitch that is excellent 2 in intermediate, open and champion class providing that the CAC has been also awarded to the first placed in that class.
Club Winner Junior	Title can be awarded to the best male and female in the junior class, awarded CAJC title at Club Show.
Club Winner	Title can be awarded to the best male and female in breed, from intermediate, open and champion class awarded CAC in the class at Club Show.
BOB Junior	Awarded to the best dog or bitch that recieved Club Winner Junior title.
BOS	Best Opposite Sex – awarded to the best specimen of the opposite sex from the BOB winner.
BOB	Awarded to the specimen in the breed – chosen out of all Club Junior Winners, Club Winners and Veteran class winner with Exc.1, in each breed.

Open	From 15 months, accessible to all dogs regardless to passed working exams or achieved championships

Honor	Accessible to all dogs with recognized national or international champion title, club winner and specialty winner titles
Out of competition	From 12 months of age. Open for cut-down dogs. Will be marked and critiqued. Not official titles.

Titles

CAJC	The qualifying certificate for the Slovak Junior Champion title can be awarded to a dog and a bitch that is excellent 1 in junior class.
CAC	The qualifying certificate for the Slovak Champion title can be awarded to a dog and a bitch that is excellent 1 in intermediate, open and champion class.
r. CAC	Can be awarded to a dog and a bitch that is excellent 2 in intermediate, open and champion class providing that the CAC has been also awarded to the first placed in that class.
Specialty Winner Junior	Title can be awarded to the best male and female in the junior class, awarded CAJC title at Specialty Show.
Specialty Winner	Title can be awarded to the best male and female in breed, from intermediate, open and champion class awarded CAC in the class at Specialty Show.
BOB Junior	Awarded to the best dog or bitch awarded Specialty Winner Junior title in Junior Class.
BOS	Best Opposite Sex – awarded to the best specimen of the opposite sex from the BOB winner.
BOB	Awarded to the best dog or bitch in each breed – chosen out of all Specialty Junior Winners, Specialty Winners and Veteran class winner with Exc.1, in each breed

Final competitions for Club show & Specialty show

Child & Dog	Competition for children from 3 to 9 years with a dog registered for the show.
Junior Handling	Exhibitor from 9 to 17 years with a dog registered for the show.
BIS Couple	Competition for a dog and a bitch of the same breed owned by one owner.
BIS Breeding Group	Competition for at least three individuals of the same breed, color and size, which come from one kennel from two different mothers or fathers.
BIS Minor Puppy	Dogs and bitches awarded with Very Promising 1 enter the competition.
BIS Puppy	Dogs and bitches awarded with Very Promising 1 enter the competition.
BIS Junior	Dogs that won BOB Junior enter the competition.
BIS Veteran	Competition for Veterans who have received Exc.1.
BIS Honor class	Competition for best individuals from the honorary class of each breed awarded Excellent.
BIS Cut-down	Competition for winners of out of competition class.
BIS	Competition for best individuals from each breed, who won the BOB title.

Veterinary regulations

Every dog must have a valid PET PASSPORT in which it will be clearly stated that the dog in concern has been vaccinated against rabies, distemper, parvovirus and hepatitis at least 21 days and at most 1 year before the date of the show, or within the validity of the given vaccination.

Upon entering the exhibition, the exhibitor is obliged to present a vaccination card for inspection. Without this, the dog will not be allowed to show.

General provisions

- The show is open to all dogs and bitches of breeds associated in KTP. The exhibitor does not have to be a member of the mentioned club. Individuals must be registered in FCI-recognized studbooks. Imported individuals in the Slovak Republic must be registered in the Slovak breeding book of SKJ.
- The exhibitor is obliged to follow the instructions of the Ring Leader and the organizers of the show in accordance with the valid provisions of the show rules FCI, SKJ and KTP.
- Exhibitor - the owner of the dog is responsible for all damages caused by the dog in the exhibition grounds. The organizer of the exhibition does not take any responsibility for damages caused by the dog or the exhibitor, or for damages caused by the death or loss of the dog at the exhibition center.
- Free walking of dogs at the show is prohibited. Each dog must have a collar and a leash. Gnawing dogs must have a muzzle. Sale of puppies during the show is strictly prohibited!
- There is one judge in the ring who may refuse to judge the dog if he enters the ring late.
- Judge change reserved!
- By registering dog, the exhibitor undertakes to comply with the regulations of the show rules SKJ, FCI, exhibition regulations and Slovak veterinary regulations and agrees to the publication of his address in the exhibition catalog and on the organizer's website. It also gives consent to the publication of photographs, results and assessments of the individual according to the needs of the organizer, SKJ and partners of the exhibition.
- By registering the dog, the exhibitor undertakes to pay all fees.
- By entering the show, exhibitor is represented as the concerned person in sense of § 13 law number 18/2018 Z.z. about protection of personal information and gives right to the organizers of the shows to use his/hers personal identification informations (name, surname) and photo documentation from the show itself, as well as publishing these informations and results at the website of the club.
- Storno fee in case of entry cancellation is 5EUR per dog, per show. Changes or cancellation of entries are possible only until the date of second closing date.

Protest

Protest against the judges' decision is inadmissible. A protest for formal reasons is admissible after a deposit of EUR 20 has been made, it must be submitted in writing at the exhibition office by the end of the assessment in circles. In the event of a decision to the detriment of the exhibitor, the deposit is forfeited in favor of the exhibition.
